


Dalbavancin expands treatment options for patients requiring IV antibiotics

Why dalbavancin?¹

- Long acting antibiotic
 - Approved treatment for acute bacterial skin and skin structure infections, including MRSA
 - One or two dose IV infusion regimen
 - Option for patients who are not candidates for self-administration or lack caregiver support
- Can be infused through a peripheral IV line
 - No central line placement required
 - Enables alternate site infusion options for patients
- Short infusion time, administered over 30 minutes
- Well tolerated with a low side effect profile
- Only requires baseline renal function for initial dosing, no ongoing laboratory monitoring required

Indications and Usage

1.1 Dalbavancin is indicated for acute bacterial skin and skin structure infections (ABSSSI) caused by designated susceptible strains of Gram-positive microorganisms.

1.2 To reduce the development of drug-resistant bacteria and maintain the effectiveness of dalbavancin and other antibacterial drugs, dalbavancin should be used only to treat infections that are proven or strongly suspected to be caused by susceptible bacteria.
